

Marching for Family Rights

The Women's Economic Agenda Project (WEAP), an Oakland-based organization addressing economic and social justice issues for financially struggling women and their families, will conduct a march through Vallejo on Saturday. The march's theme is to emphasize a family's right to affordable health care and access to substance abuse recovery options.

Participants and supporters will gather at 9:30 a.m. at Washington Park on the corner of El Dorado and Ohio Streets. The march begins at 10:30 a.m. taking participants along Sonoma Boulevard, Nebraska, Marin, Mississippi, Sacramento and Georgia Streets. The event concludes with a rally at noon on the steps of City Hall, 555 Santa Clara St. The week-long march began Monday in San Jose and will end Monday in Oakland.
